

Coordinated Entry

A streamlined intake and assessment process for people experiencing homelessness to access supportive services.

People experiencing, or at risk of, homelessness will first receive emergency assistance through:

Using a coordinated and standard process to one of four interventions that will end their homelessness.

A strong homelessness response system utilizes coordinated entry to quickly connect people who experience homelessness to housing assistance and/or services tailored to the unique strengths and needs of households and which enable them to achieve and maintain permanent housing.
